



OWNER STORM PREPAREDNESS RESPONSIBILITIES

IF EVACUATING:

- Remove all furniture and belongings from your balcony before leaving.
- Remove all food from your refrigerator and freezer before leaving.
- Turn off the water to your unit at the master shut off as you leave.
- Take all legal documents, medicines & prescriptions and your insurance policy with you.
- Place disposable diapers or water snakes in the tracks of both sliding glass doors and the inside of your front door.
- Management will not distribute keys to friends or other owners during the disaster recovery.
- Do not call the office for information about your unit, the management will contact owners individually or by group email as soon as possible or as needed.

IF NOT EVACUATING:

- Remove all furniture and belongings from your balcony.
- Purchase food & water for 5-7 days minimum.
- Fill tub and sinks with water.
- Refill prescriptions.
- Purchase flashlights or lanterns, weather radio and necessary batteries.
- Move car to upper level of the garage.
- Notify family members of your plans to stay.

If a hurricane makes landfall, our emergency generator only provides power to one elevator and emergency lighting. The generator will only be operational during set times of the day. There will be no air conditioning in the units or in the common areas of the building. Cell phone service will be limited. Restaurants, grocery stores, drug stores, gas stations and banks are typically closed.

IF A MANDATORY EVACUATION IS DECLARED THERE WILL BE NO COMMUNITY (911) SERVICE AVAILABLE.
